Synopsis:

Rhinoplasty is an apparent aesthetic surgery across many corners in Asia continent with the fact to see how popular the procedure in Europe, North and South America, including increasing trend in Australia and South Africa. Interestingly, Middle East is placed at the top seeded site with the most procedure performed statistically. Joining a rhinoplasty course to follow the trend of aesthetic surgery across the globe would never be a wrong decision. Although the topics on Asian rhinoplasty represent most of the Asian population, the experts of the Southeast Asia region could have a more intensive forum discussing the nitty gritty of rhinoplasty specific to their people. The session covers the advances of surgical technique to beautify the nose, anatomical characteristics of Asian noses along with the functional aspects would always be the benchmarks. Flap surgery is considered as one of the most interesting and fast developing subjects in reconstructive surgery. A thread lift is a minimally invasive cosmetic technique that tightens and lifts the skin with temporary stitches, giving the appearance of a modest but noticeable lift. Patients in their late thirties to early fifties are the greatest candidates for treatment, as it is usually utilized for mild to moderate indications of skin laxity. Thread lifts are a fantastic choice for those who are not eligible for surgery due to certain medical issues because they may be done under local anaesthesia. The threads disintegrate and are eventually absorbed by the body; the effects of a thread lift are transient, lasting anywhere from one to three years. The most common complications are bruising, swelling, and infection, all of which can be managed without surgery. Expert-instructors will take participants through fun learning experiences discussing the ideal thread lift management. Along with strategies, participants will also acquire a mindset shift in the complete execution of thread lift management.

- Title (maximum 20 words)
- Keywords (maximum 4)
- Abstract body (maximum 300 words, including the following sections)
- Objectives: At least 2 clear and measurable objectives
- Background: A brief statement on why the study was conducted
- Methods: The methods of study or experimental approach must be briefly defined
- Results: A summary of the study results, including sufficient detail to support the conclusions
- Conclusions: A statement explaining the significance of the study and its implications for further research
- Authors (maximum 11): Include full names with institution and country
- Preferred Presentation Type: You may indicate your preferred presentation type Oral or E-Poster but the Abstract Selection Committee will make the final format determination
- Disclose conflict of interest and accept terms and conditions

Editing

Abstracts may be edited until the submission deadline. After that, no changes in content or co-authors may be made. Once the review process begins, no changes to submissions are allowed — no exceptions. Please note that any typographical or spelling errors, improperly formatted titles, etc., WILL NOT be edited by anyone at the Organizing Committee. It is the responsibility of the Submitting Author to review and verify all work submitted.

Abstract Selection

Notification of the Abstract Selection Committee's decision will be sent by May 12th, 2025 via email to the Submitting Author, regardless of the outcome.

Registration/Attendance Requirement

The Presenting Author (Oral or E-Poster) must register for and attend the Congress. Registration must be completed by July 14th, 2025. If a Presenting Author does not register by the deadline, all accepted abstracts by that Presenting Author will be removed from the program.
