Synopsis:

Rhinoplasty is an apparent aesthetic surgery across many corners in Asia continent with the fact to see how popular the procedure in Europe, North and South America, including increasing trend in Australia and South Africa. Interestingly, Middle East is placed at the top seeded site with the most procedure performed statistically. Joining a rhinoplasty course to follow the trend of aesthetic surgery across the globe would never be a wrong decision. Although the topics on Asian rhinoplasty represent most of the Asian population, the experts of the Southeast Asia region could have a more intensive forum discussing the nitty gritty of rhinoplasty specific to their people. The session covers the advances of surgical technique to beautify the nose, anatomical characteristics of Asian noses along with the functional aspects would always be the benchmarks. Understanding the conceptual framework and the use of autologous cartilage would bring the participants a set of broad knowledge before embarking into the main topic on the use of rib cartilage graft. Implant use would always be welcome to be discussed as an alternative technique. The experts will entertain the participants by performing the live surgery that comes along with interactive discussion. Two moderators who are experienced in performing rhinoplasty will bring the learning session to be entertaining.

Synopsis:

With the rise of rhinoplasty surgery supported by the high demand in aesthetic surgery, deep plane facelift has become a very popular technique among many other facelift techniques. The purpose of this aesthetic course is to demonstrate how to do the deep plane technique correctly while enriching the knowledge and aesthetic sense of plastic surgeons interested in performing facelifts. - Preferred Presentation Type: You may indicate your preferred presentation type - Oral or E-Poster - but the Abstract Selection Committee will make the final format determination
- Disclose conflict of interest and accept terms and conditions

Editing

Abstracts may be edited until the submission deadline. After that, no changes in content or co-authors may be made. Once the review process begins, no changes to submissions are allowed — no exceptions.
